Nurturing the world's forests

The forest products trade, estimated at \$300 billion a year, is a vast global industry. Deforestation – which claims 13 million hectares (32 million acres) of forest each year – contributes approximately 20 percent of greenhouse gases causing climate change.

We are surrounded with the fibre of forests from around the world from products such as paper, magazines, construction materials, sports equipment and furniture. Few of us know the origin of these forest products or whether they were responsibly managed and legally harvested before making their way into our homes and offices.

A critical tool in the race to save the world's forests is Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC) certification. Founded in 1993, FSC is an international NGO certification and labeling system that promotes the responsible management of the world's working forests. It is supported by social-welfare and workers' rights groups, timber industry representatives, and the environmental and conservation community.

Pacific Hygiene have 25 products that are FSC certified including the Pacific Green 100% recycled range and we continue to work with our supply partners to get FSC certification across our product range enabling our customers to choose products that support responsible forest management.
